Low Tech Low Cost Surface Enhancement: Techniques will include rolled ink, egg shell finish, resist burning, decoupage, and whatever else I find in my toolbox.

Multiple Axis Vessel: This will be one way to turn a hollow vessel on more than one axis. For those who are a little off kilter.

Two Piece Hollow Vessel: A how-to of making a hollow vessel with a small opening. Conversation about fundamentals of wood working will be included.

Clay's quiet confidence in doing work that is just a bit non-traditional in woodturning today may inspire you to be more adventurous in your work.
